## SKILLS ASSESSMENT TOOL

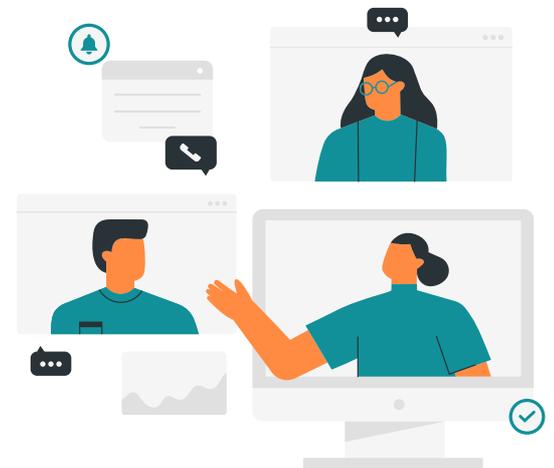
### TOOLKIT EXPLANATION

This toolkit will lead to the creation of the skills map toolset and explanatory interview guidance. Taking stock of the findings gathered in the Study circles, we will create the content for the skills map in terms of precise indicators and descriptors to evaluate someone making the illiteracy workshops, on the skills map. In fact, people will first place themselves knowing only the descriptors, then an external person such as a trainer will accompany the person to make a second positioning using their self-evaluation and adding his/her expertise. This procedure will allow to qualify the progress made during the thematic workshops but also help the trainee to explain themselves their progress.

The creation of the map with precise indicators and descriptors as well as guiding literacy is very precious to us as it means that the skills map may be implemented in any area where there is a fight against illiteracy and without changing the content. It ensures a wide implementation.

### CONTENT OF THE TOOLKIT:

The main idea is to establish a methodology to evaluate a person gaining literacy skills using the established skills map by self-positioning and guided positioning.

With this evaluation made before and after the workshop, users of the methodology can precisely show the effect and impact of the methodology on someone's skills.

*Before:* Recognition and initial assessment of skills.

*After:* Recognition and final evaluation of the acquired/developed skills.

Tools:

- Skills map.
- Individual interview.

On the basis of the evaluated skills and the progress made we can determine the possible integration of trainings or work through an explanatory interview.

In the toolkit you can find these elements:

- A Skills Map tool to be printed out double sided, so to have the gradation and the icons on one side, and the explanatory written grid with the skills on the corresponding back space.
- A Skills Map descriptor sheet corresponding to all skills in the above-mentioned tool.
- A full curriculum with timed activities for workshops to acquire the skills in 4 workshops.
- A set of ready to implement activities in workshop settings.
