About the project

The project "DIGIT4ALL" is an Erasmus+ KA2 project that aims to support individuals in acquiring and developing basic digital skills by providing them access to computers and digital training. The main goal of the project is to enhance integration in the workforce and society while promoting the need for the sustainable reuse of digital equipment. This will be achieved through several workshops that will offer people guidance on how to access common digital tools and upgrade their digital knowledge using open-source software. Additionally, the project aims to improve access to training and qualifications for all.



Exploring the First Phase of the Digit4all Project: Research and Study Circles

Our journey commences with the initial phases of the Digit4all Project: Desk Research, Field Research, and Study Circles.



Desk Research: This component involves an in-depth examination of current literature, policies, and established theoretical and methodological approaches related to the project's design, development, and implementation. We are curating a collection of best practices and tools that have already proven effective in addressing digital illiteracy.

Field Research: Our project partners have thoughtfully presented two exemplary practices currently in operation at local, regional, or national levels. These initiatives directly address the issue of digital illiteracy. The insights gained from these practices provide us with valuable case studies and lessons learned. This knowledge equips us to identify existing needs, challenges, and issues related to digital illiteracy among adults.

Study Circles: To facilitate comprehensive learning, we have recommended study circles with a minimum duration of 12 hours, distributed across 3-4 hour sessions, and involving a minimum of 12 participants. We advise the inclusion of an experienced facilitator well-versed in the topic of digitalization and knowledgeable about the local and national context.

2nd Partners Meeting in Germany,Leipzig 25-26 May 2023

From May 25th to May 26th, 2023, Wisamar was the venue for the second meeting of the DIGIT4ALL project in Germany. During this meeting, partners engaged in in-depth discussions and made several important decisions:

Next Steps: A consensus was reached on the project's future steps, which encompass defining learning objectives, shaping curricular activities, creating teaching materials, and formulating assessment methods.

Module Creation: Critical dates were established for the development of the project's five modules, marking a pivotal phase in the project's progression.

Workshop Activities: Plans were solidified for two forthcoming workshop activities, pivotal for advancing the project and ensuring active participant engagement.

Upcoming Meetings: Partners formalized the schedule for the next partners' meeting and set the dates for the Learning, Teaching, and Training Activity, slated for January 16th to 18th, 2024, in Spain.
